We work with people living with a disability or who have a permanent medical condition, injury or mental health issue. We help you find meaningful work tailored to your strengths and abilities so you can thrive in life.

Our programs help you make connections that foster independence and contribute to local economies.



Disability Employment Service (DES)

This program is for both job seekers and employers so they can connect and create meaningful work opportunities. We provide employment pathways, training, and vocational opportunities.

If you're looking for a job, we support you with specialised training and connect you to a network of employers to find you a role that is right for you.

If you're an employer, we can find employees that are right for your business, tailoring support to suit your business requirements with optional assistance in job design, position descriptions and advertising.

School Leaver Employment Service (SLES)

If you've recently left or are in the final years of school, we can help you take the important step from school to employment.

We offer:

- mentoring and ongoing support,
- access to accredited training,
- work placements,
- industry visits,
- driver education to get your learner's permit,
- skills development and confidence building.

Our Pathways to Employment program, funded by NDIS, will help meet your individual needs. We will help you finish your training, get a qualification and complete your work experience to help you find the right job.
