Bills and expense assistance

If you're unable to pay bills or if paying them would leave you without money to pay for food or the rent, then our Bills and Expense Assistance could help you.

This service can help you pay your utility bills, medical costs, transport, housing, and back-to-school costs.

Food vouchers, food and material aid

During times of crisis we can provide nonperishable food, food vouchers, personal care items and household goods. We can also connect you with other services to help you get your life back on track.

Community meals

Our Community Meals program cooks nutritious meals for people to take home or eat in a safe, inclusive and welcoming environment. If you're experiencing homelessness, in crisis or just in need of a feed, you can enjoy a meal and chat with people in the community.

Our freshly made meals cater for a range of dietary requirements. You don't need to book ahead so you can get a free or a low-cost meal when you need it.
