

We have services and programs to give you the knowledge and tools to improve your financial security and independence.

How financial support and education helps you

Our programs provide the financial information and options you need to manage your household expenses and give you the skills to manage your finances better. All programs are offered in a judgement-free, supportive environment so you can live a more independent life.

Financial counselling

Financial counselling is a free service where information, suggested options, advocacy and support are provided to people experiencing financial difficulties.

Energy support program

A service to help households who are facing challenges with their energy bills. An energy assessor can come to your home or meet with you over the phone to look at your energy use and identify ways to help you reduce your energy consumption and save you money. Loans to help you get back on your feet

A No-Interest Loan (NIL) is a safe way to pay for essential goods and services when compared to quick cash loans, Afterpay and appliance rental schemes. Our NILs can be used for vital household items, some medical and dental bills, education necessities or car-related expenses.
