Reporting Antisocial Behaviour from other Residents

Urgent or Criminal Behaviour

If you feel unsafe, are experiencing any form of physical abuse or threats of violence or witness any criminal activity, **please contact Victoria Police** <u>before</u> contacting Uniting.

What Happens Next

Your report will be reviewed by our team. If the behavior breaches the Residential Tenancies Act, we may take formal action by issuing a 'Breach of Duty Notice'. This requires the resident to stop the behavior and/or compensate for any damage caused.

Anonymity and its limitations

Residents are encouraged to report anti-social behavior and may choose to remain anonymous, however **remaining anonymous will restrict Uniting from taking formal action**. For Uniting to take formal action and issue a 'Breach of Duty Notice' under the Residential Tenancies Act (RTA) you cannot remain anonymous and may be required to attend a VCAT hearing.

Limitations on Updates:

Due to Privacy laws, we may not be able to provide you with detailed updates about the outcome of your report. However, please be assured that all reports are taken seriously and acted upon in accordance with the law.
