To support businesses like yours in providing people living with disability fair employment opportunities, the federal government has set up the Wage Subsidy Scheme.

We match employment opportunities to candidates who are trained, skilled and a good fit for your business and continue to provide ongoing support as they ease into their role.

What is the Wage Subsidy Scheme?

The Wage Subsidy Scheme is a financial incentive of up to \$1,650 (GST inclusive), made available to qualifying businesses to give eligible jobseekers an opportunity to demonstrate their suitability for ongoing employment.

The Wage Subsidy Scheme is not intended for current employees of the business, and the job must be for at least 8 hours per week over a period of 13 weeks.

To be eligible for a wage subsidy, a business needs to have:

- An Australian Business Number (ABN)
- Not previously received a wage subsidy for the same position
- Not recently retrenched or reduced the number of workers, or be proposing to do so
- Not bring the wage subsidy or the Commonwealth Government into disrepute
- Not be receiving another government wage subsidy for the same worker or position.
